RANNIS - EEA Services and activities outside Iceland

RANNIS - EEA services and activities in Iceland

Increase the visibility of the EEA grants in Iceland. Promotes the programmes and associated events (e.g. Matchmaking events) as well as providing information on the general objectives of the scheme and open calls for applications.

Facilitates bilateral cooperation between Iceland and EEA-recipient countries.
